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Game is no longer plentiful in Swaziland, and hunting parties are rare, but this is a traditional song which used to be used when hunting buck: "He stabbed the buck, but it run away. It cried 'me-e'!" The tumultuous shouting at the end, however, seems to imply that the hunters were finally successful. The short repeated chorus phrase is sung in parallel 4ths. It frequently overlaps the leader's phrase, provising three-part polyphony, and reiterating the two contrasting roots, a semitone apart. The mode is hemitonal penta, as represented in diagram b).
