This is one from among a number of dance-songs performed at royal weddings. The leader's part describes some of the King's attributes, while the words of the chorus refer to the King as "the Great Elephant, who defeats his enemies merely by playing with them". As in the previous song, spoken praises are occasionally also recited. The tonality is simpler than in item 5, employing a version of the penta mode represented in diagram b), like the hunting song (No.4). The overall pitch rises by the same amount as in the previous dance song.
