Instruments-Chant: Foresinger: Sigmundur Jacobsen	Forme d'expression: Concerning whalehunting in the Faroe Islands. After whalehunting there used to be dance, socalled grindadansur; while waiting for the whale, which belonged to certain boats from certain villages, or waiting for information about which whales they were in the right to cut and bring home, the men used to dance, sometimes for a whole night, keeping themselves warm and awake. This was of course also entertainment for the whole village in which the hunting or killing had taken place, and then it was tradition to sing Grindavisan, as it is still in many places.
