Ka-kok is, in general, a common name with melody. Today Ka-kok in the Korean music is also called "Man-nyun Jang-hwan Ji Kok" or "the tune of Eternal Joy", and it indicates singing a song with Shi-jo (Poem).

This tune was derived from the music of the Koryo Dynasty's "Jin-jak".

The Ka-kok shares to the same text which shi-jo (Poem) give the whole Poem but while Ka-kok divides it into five lines, Shi-jo divides it into three lines.
